Sec. 26-71. Creation.

It is hereby declared to be in the best interests of the City to create an economic development revolving loan fund (sales tax) advisory committee to be composed of eight members, all of whom are to be selected for their wisdom, ability, and community-wide perspective and not for the purpose of representing any specific group or segment within the community. Residence within the City limits shall not be a requirement of membership.

Sec. 26-72. Ex officio members.

The City Manager, a member of the Governing Body, and the president of the Pittsburgh Area Chamber of Commerce shall be ex officio members of the Economic Development Revolving Loan Fund Committee but shall not be entitled to vote on any matter considered by the committee.

Sec. 26-73. Duties.

The duties of the Economic Development Revolving Loan Fund (sales tax) Advisory Committee shall be to screen the applications of those applying for assistance from either the economic development revolving loan fund (sales tax) or the community development block grant revolving loan fund based upon the criteria and guidelines for the funds as established from time to time by the Governing Body and, thereafter, make recommendations to the Governing Body with regard to such applications. Further, the committee, if so directed by the Governing Body, shall also make recommendations regarding tax abatement, industrial revenue bonds, and other financial assistance.

Sec. 26-74. Appointment and term.

Each member shall be appointed by a majority vote of the Governing Body. Of the first five members appointed, two shall serve for a term of two years and three for a term of three years; thereafter, all members shall be appointed for three-year terms. Upon the inability to serve or resignation of any member, the Governing Body shall appoint someone to fill the unexpired term.

Sec. 26-75. Eligibility for reappointment.

No individual shall be eligible for reappointment after he has served two consecutive terms on the committee.
