Sealed bids will be received until **2:00 p.m.** local time, on **May 28, 2026**, at the **City of Pittsburg, 201 W 4th Street, Pittsburg, Kansas** and then publicly opened and read aloud, for furnishing all labor, materials and equipment and performing all work necessary to: Rehabilitate Runway 17/35 and Runway 17 Turnaround. In general, this work will require the following approximate quantities:

Asphalt Crack Repair (50,900 LF); Marking Removal (44,261 SF); Cold Milling (For Partial Depth Pavement Repair) (1,396 SY); 3" Asphalt Partial Depth Pavement Repair (285 TN); Asphalt Surface Treatment (74,867 SY); Painting

This project is subject to the requirements of 49 CFR Part 26 Disadvantaged Business Enterprise Participation. The Airport Sponsor has established a contract participation goal of 0% for small business concerns owned and controlled by certified disadvantaged business enterprises (DBE). The Owner's award of this contract is conditioned upon the bidder satisfying the good faith effort requirements of 49 CFR § 26.53.
