



Adopt-A-Street APPLICATION

The City Of Pittsburg's Adopt-A-Street Program is part of an effort to make our city streets litter free. The program is voluntary, designed for all types of group organizations and is open to groups that do not discriminate on the basis of race, religion, color or sex. Each volunteer (adopting) group assumes responsibility for an assigned section of street and agrees to remove litter and trash four (4) times a year for a two (2) year period. The City of Pittsburg will work with the adopting group to select the specific section of street to be adopted. Some streets may not be considered for a number of reasons, usually safety related.
