### **ORDINANCE NO. G-1265**

AN ORDINANCE amending Sections 62-41 and 62-101 of the Pittsburg City Code to provide that the members of the Planning Commission and the Board of Zoning Appeals shall be the same persons.

BE IT ORDAINED BY THE GOVERNING BODY OF THE CITY OF PITTSBURG, KANSAS:

<u>Section 1.</u> Section 62-41 of the Pittsburg City Code is amended to read as follows:

### Section 62-41. Creation.

There is hereby created a Planning Commission. It shall consist of seven members appointed by the Governing Body. Five of the members must be residents of the City, and two of the members shall reside outside of but within three miles of the corporate limits of the City. The members of the Planning Commission shall also serve as the members of the Board of Zoning Appeals and shall serve the term for which they were appointed by the Governing Body. Upon the expiration of the term of any member, the Governing Body shall appoint that members or some other qualified individual to a three year term of office; provided, however, that no members shall serve more than two consecutive terms.

Section 2. Section 62-101 of the Pittsburg City Code is amended to read as follows:

#### Section 62-101. Creation.

There is hereby created a Board of Zoning Appeals. It shall consist of seven members appointed by the Governing Body. Five members must be residents of the City, and two of the members shall reside outside of but within three miles of the corporate limits of the City. The members of the Board of Zoning Appeals shall also serve as the members of the Planning Commission and shall serve the term for which they were appointed by the Governing Body. Upon the expiration of the term of any member, the Governing Body shall appoint that member or some other qualified individual to a three-year term of office; provided, however, that no members shall serve more than two consecutive terms.

Section 3. This Ordinance shall take effect upon its passage and publication in the official city paper.
