A Regular Session of the Board of Commissioners was held at 5:30 p.m. on Tuesday, September 12th, 2017, in the City Commission Room, located in the Law Enforcement Center, 201 North Pine, with Mayor Michael Gray presiding and the following members present: Jeremy Johnson, John Ketterman, Chuck Munsell, and Patrick O'Bryan.

A moment of silence was observed in memory of the late Dr. Jim AuBuchon.

Mayor Gray led the flag salute.

APPROVAL OF MINUTES – AUGUST 22^{nd} , 2017 - On motion of O'Bryan, seconded by Johnson, the Governing Body approved the August 22^{nd} , 2017, City Commission Meeting minutes as submitted. Motion carried.

AUDITING CONTRACT – MIZE HOUSER & COMPANY – On motion of O'Bryan, seconded by Johnson, the Governing Body approved the 2017 auditing contract with Mize Houser & Company P.A. in an amount not to exceed \$35,535 to perform auditing services for the City's 2017 fiscal year end and authorized the Mayor to sign the appropriate documents on behalf of the City. Motion carried.

APPROPRIATION ORDINANCE – On motion of O'Bryan, seconded by Johnson, the Governing Body approved the Appropriation Ordinance for the period ending September 12th, 2017, subject to the release of HUD expenditures when funds are received with the following roll call vote: Yea: Gray, Johnson, Ketterman, Munsell and O'Bryan. Motion carried.

DISPOSITION OF BIDS – 2017 ASPHALT REJUVENATION PROJECT – On motion of Ketterman, seconded by Gray, the Governing Body approved staff recommendation to award the bid for the 2017 Asphalt Rejuvenation Project to Proseal, Inc., of El Dorado, Kansas, based on their low bid of \$1.07 per square yard, and authorized the Mayor to sign the contract agreement once prepared. Motion carried.

POINTE ROYALE LOAN — On motion of Johnson, seconded by O'Bryan, the Governing Body approved staff recommendation to modify the loan previously granted to Pointe Royale Development, Inc. in the amount of \$300,000 to replace Pointe Royale Development, Inc. with the newly created entity for the development, Pittsburg Highlands, LP, with the terms and conditions of the loan to remain unmodified, and authorized the Mayor to sign the necessary documents on behalf of the City. Motion carried.

RESOLUTION NO. 1197 – On motion of Ketterman, seconded by Gray, the Governing Body adopted Resolution No. 1197, determining that the City is considering establishing a Rural Housing Incentive District within the City and adopting a plan for the development of housing and public facilities in such proposed district; establishing the date and time of a public hearing on such matter, and providing for the giving of notice of such public hearing, and authorized the Mayor to sign Resolution No. 1197 on behalf of the City. Motion carried.

ENGINEERING SERVICES AGREEMENT - WASTEWATER TREATMENT PLANT PRELIMINARY STUDY - On motion of Munsell, seconded by Ketterman, the Governing Body approved the Engineering Services Agreement between the City of Pittsburg and Earles Engineering & Inspection, Inc., in an amount not to exceed \$80,000, in which Earles Engineering & Inspection, Inc. will develop a Preliminary Engineering Study of the Wastewater Treatment Plant and authorized the City Manager to sign the engineering services agreement on behalf of the City. Motion carried.

DISPOSITION OF BIDS – 2017 STREET IMPROVEMENTS PROJECT – Following a verbal recommendation by Director of Public Utilities Matt Bacon, on motion of O'Bryan, seconded by Johnson, the Governing Body approved the low bid submitted by Heckert Construction Co., Inc. of Pittsburg, Kansas, in the amount of \$498,322.74, for the 2017 Street Improvements Project and authorized the Mayor and City Clerk to execute the contract documents once they are prepared. Motion carried.

NON-AGENDA REPORTS & REQUESTS - Director of Finance Jamie Clarkson provided the August 31, 2017, bi-monthly budget review.

NON-AGENDA REPORTS & REQUESTS — City Manager Daron Hall stated that he appreciated Dr. AuBuchon's friendship and dedication to the City of Pittsburg.

OPTION AGREEMENT FOR THE PURCHASE OF REAL ESTATE

This OPTION AGREEMENT FOR TH	E PURCHASI	E OF REAL PROPERTY
(hereinafter "Agreement") is entered on this	day of	, 2017, by and
between the City of Pittsburg, Kansas, a munici	ipal corporatio	n, with offices at 201 West 4 th
Street, Pittsburg, Kansas, 66762 (hereinafter, "C	Owner") and S	ugar Creek Packing Co., a foreign
corporation authorized to do business in the Sta	ite of Kansas, l	located at 12021 Sheraton Lane,
Cincinnati, Ohio, 45246 (hereinafter "Purchaser	r").	

WITNESSETH

WHEREAS, Owner is owner of a certain parcel of real property located in Crawford County, State of Kansas, more particularly described in attached Exhibit "A" (hereinafter the "Property");

WHEREAS, Purchaser desires to obtain an option to purchase the Property within a certain period of time (hereinafter "Option"), in order to protect Purchaser's investment in its manufacturing campus located at 1600 West McKay Street, Frontenac, Kansas, 66763.

WHEREAS, Owner is willing to give Purchaser said Option in return for the financial consideration as set forth in this Agreement,

WHEREAS, the parties desire to reduce their agreement to writing.

THEREFORE, for good and valuable consideration, the receipt of which is hereby acknowledged, the parties stipulate and agree as follows:

AGREEMENT

- 1. **Property.** Owner represents and warrants that it is the beneficial and rightful owner of the Property, with good and marketable title free and clear of all security interests, mortgages, liens, pledges, charges, claims, or encumbrances of any kind or character, except for those listed on the "Permitted Exceptions" addendum hereto.
- 2. Granting and Exercising of Option. Owner grants Purchaser five (5) separate exercisable one (1) year irrevocable Options (hereinafter "Option Term") to purchase the Property on the terms and conditions set forth in this Agreement. Purchaser may exercise any Option unilaterally prior to expiration of any current one (1) year Option Term. Purchaser shall exercise any Option by delivering written notice and payment of the purchase price to Owner at Owner's address, as set forth above, with standard U.S. postmarked mail service to the attention of the City Manager. The initial one (1) year Option shall commence upon execution of this Agreement by the parties, and payment of the first (1st) Option Price.

- **3. Option Price and Terms.** The consideration Purchaser shall pay for each separate Option Term, shall be Five Thousand Dollars and No Cents (\$5,000.00) (hereinafter "Option Price"). Each Option Price must be made to Owner prior to the expiration of the then current Option Term or this Agreement shall be rendered null and void.
- **4. Purchase Price.** If purchaser exercises its Option, the price Purchaser shall pay for the Property shall be Two Hundred Fifty Thousand Dollars and No Cents (\$250,000.00) (hereinafter "Purchase Price").
- **5.** Closing. Closing for said Purchase under this Option shall take place within sixty (60) days of Purchaser giving written notice to Owner, notifying Owner of Purchaser's intent to exercise the Option to purchase the Property (hereinafter "Closing"). However, at no time shall Closing take place later than December 31, 2022. Therefore, Purchaser shall notify owner of its intent to exercise this Option no later than the expiration of the fifth (5th) and final Option Term. Purchaser shall be entitled to possession of the Property upon Closing.
- **6. Payment of Purchase Price.** Upon Purchaser's exercise of this Option, the Purchaser shall pay for the entire Purchase Price, in cash or its equivalent, at Closing.
- 7. **Title.** Upon the terms and conditions agreed to and set forth herein, at the Closing, Owner shall convey to Purchaser, by municipal warranty deed, with good and indefeasible marketable title in fee simple to the Property free and clear of any and all liens, encumbrances, conditions, easements, restrictions and other conditions, except for any Permitted Exceptions.
- **8.** Closing Costs. Owner shall be responsible for preparation of the municipal warranty deed to Purchaser, and Purchaser shall be responsible for the cost of recording said deed. Real estate taxes, if any, shall be prorated between the parties as of the date of Closing. All other and further closing costs shall be paid for by the party that incurs said costs.
- **9. Title Policy.** If Purchaser so desires, Owner shall deliver to Purchaser at Closing a standard coverage form of Owner Policy of Title Insurance in the full amount of the Purchase Price, insuring Purchaser's indefeasible fee simple title to the Property subject only to the Permitted Exceptions and the taxes for the year of Closing and subsequent assessments for prior years due to change in land and usage or ownership.
- 10. Liens Against Property. Owner and Purchaser hereby agree that there shall be no liens placed upon the Property by either Owner or Purchaser, during the term of this Agreement and the Property transferred to Purchaser upon the exercise of this Option shall be delivered free of all liens of any kind. Additionally, Purchaser shall indemnify and hold harmless the Owner against and from any and all liens, mechanics or otherwise that may be placed upon this Property related either directly or indirectly to Purchaser's actions, or its agents or assigns.

11. Option Assignable. Owner agrees that purchaser may assign this Option on or before Closing with written consent of Owner.

12. Miscellaneous.

- **a.** Entire Agreement. This Agreement embodies the entire agreement between the parties and cannot be varied except by the written agreement of the parties.
- **b. Survival.** All promises, representations and warranties intended to extend beyond the closing date shall survive the Closing.
- **c. Notices.** Any notice required or permitted to be delivered hereunder shall be deemed to be delivered (a) when delivered, personally, or (b) when deposited in the United States mail, postage prepaid, addressed to Seller or Purchaser, as the case may be, addressed as follows:

Such addresses may be changed from time to time by either party by providing written notice in the matter set forth above.

- **d.** Successors and Assigns. All of the terms and conditions of this Agreement are hereby made binding on the successors and permitted assigns of both parties hereto
- e. Governing Law. This Agreement shall be governed by and construed in accordance with the laws of the State of Kansas, and venue for any disputes shall be in Crawford County.
- **f.** Attorney Fees. In the event that a legal action is brought to enforce the terms of this Agreement, the prevailing party shall be entitled to collect its costs of court, including reasonable attorney's fees.
- g. Severability. If any provision of this Agreement is held to be illegal, invalid or unenforceable under present or future laws, such provision shall be fully severable, and this Agreement shall be construed and enforced as if such illegal, invalid or unenforceable provision had never comprised a part of this Agreement, and the remaining provisions of this Agreement shall remain in full force from this Agreement, provided that both parties may still effectively realize the complete benefit of the transaction contemplated hereby.

h. Amendments. No modification or amendment of this Agreement shall be effective unless made in writing and executed by both Owner and Purchaser. In the event any approval or consent is required pursuant to any provision of this Agreement, such approval or consent shall be deemed given only if it is in writing, executed by the party whose approval or consent is required.
