In the absence of both the Chairperson and the Vice Chairperson, Cameron Alden ran the meeting.

APPROVAL OF MINUTES – June 4 – Due to no quorum no minutes were approved. This item will be brought to the July meeting for approval.

Cameron Alden gave project updates for the KCS Crossing on Rouse, South Rouse Street Widening and Trail Project, Memorial Drive Trail Project and the North Medical District Trail which will go before the Governing Body for approval tonight at 5:30 p.m. during a regularly scheduled meeting.

There was a discussion on the Preferred Bike Route signs. Staff has placed the order however the order has not come in yet.

The Marketing Project was discussed with the emphasis on a possible intern to work under the existing Public Relations Officer for the City of Pittsburg.

Safety concerns from the Board were also discussed. There was a discussion regarding sidewalks on Joplin being covered with grass on Joplin Street.


