

OFFICIAL MINUTES  
OF THE MEETING OF THE  
ACTIVE TRANSPORTATION ADVISORY BOARD  
CITY OF PITTSBURG, KANSAS  
August 6, 2019

A Regular Session of the Active Transportation Advisory Board was held at 12:01 p.m. on Tuesday, July 9, 2019, in the City Commission Room, located in the Law Enforcement Center, 201 North Pine, with Vice Chairperson Darrell Pulliam presiding and the following members present: Deborah McGeorge, Dick Horton, Geoffrey Hines.

Chairperson – Stacey Bacon and John Robb were absent.

**APPROVAL OF MINUTES – June 4** – On motion of McGeorge, seconded by Hines the minutes of the June 4, 2019 were approved with the corrections in the first paragraph Chairperson be named as Stacey Bacon and meeting location be specified as the Upstairs Conference Room of City Hall. On motion of Horton, seconded by Hines, the minutes from the July 9, 2019 meeting were approved as submitted.


**PROJECT UPDATES** – Cameron Alden gave project updates for the KCS Crossing on Rouse, South Rouse Street Widening and Trail Project, Memorial Drive Trail Project, the North Medical District Trail and the Bike Route Signs.

**MARKETING** – The Public Relations Director is working on getting a Marketing Intern who will partially be responsible for assisting with the marketing projects of the Active Transportation Advisory Board. Dick Horton mentioned he would like to see a video from a Go-Pro or drone of the trails and the City. Deborah McGeorge indicated she is willing to ride the trails with a Go-Pro. There was a request to get information out to the public regarding Sharrows.

**QUADRANT SAFETY CONCERNS** – There was a concern regarding the Sharrows being placed to the right of the lane instead of in the middle of the lane. It was suggested to put in signs indicating cyclists may use the full lane. On the Northwest Corner of Kansas and Broadway there is a bush overgrown impeding the line of site for traffic and at southeast corner of 23<sup>rd</sup> and Joplin there is a bush that needs to be trimmed. 8-10 feet of the sidewalk on the East side of Joplin from PSU to Centennial is graveled and needs to be replaced.

**NEW MEMBERS** – With the resignation of Stacey Bacon there is an opening. Deborah Anthony has expressed an interest in being on the Board. Kim Vogel will get the application and information to her.

**ADJOURNMENT** – The meeting dismissed at 1:00 p.m. GH moved DM seconded. Motion carried. The next tentatively scheduled meeting has been set for September 9, 2019.
