Sec. 14-51. - Established.

There is hereby established in the City an Airport Advisory Board for the purpose of advising the City Manager and City Commissioners on matters pertaining to the continued growth and improvement of the airport.

Sec. 14-52. - Membership; terms.

The Airport Advisory Board shall consist of seven members, five of whom shall be users of the airport and two of whom shall be nonusers; all of whom shall serve without pay. The two nonuser members shall be residents of the City. Such persons shall be appointed by the Governing Body, and their term shall be for three years, with no person to serve more than two consecutive terms. One of the initial nonusers shall be appointed to a two-year term and the other to a three-year term. The members of the current Airport Advisory Board shall serve the terms for which they were appointed.

Sec. 14-53. - Meetings; organization.

The Airport Advisory Board shall meet and organize its membership, electing one of its members as chairperson and one of its members as secretary. The board shall meet once each quarter as well as at the request of the Mayor or City Manager or at the request of the majority of the members of such board, with the board establishing its own operating procedures.

Sec. 14-54. - Duties.

The Airport Advisory Board shall recommend and make suggestions to the City Manager and Governing Body regarding the continued growth of, and public improvements to, the airport, including the acquisition of additional property, the construction and reconstruction of airport

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facilities, and institution of programs and procedures which will increase usage of such facilities. In addition, the board shall make recommendations and reports to the Governing Body on all matters within a reasonable time after such request is made by the Governing Body.
