

OFFICIAL MINUTES
OF THE MEETING OF THE
ACTIVE TRANSPORTATION ADVISORY BOARD

January 7, 2020

A Regular Session of the Active Transportation Advisory Board was held at 12:01 p.m. on Tuesday, January 7, 2020, in the Upstairs Conference Room, located inside City Hall, 201 West 4th Street, with Chairperson, Darrell Pulliam presiding and the following members present: Deborah Anthony, Deborah McGeorge, John Robb, and Dick Horton. Kim Vogel, Director of Parks and Recreation and Cameron Alden, Director of Public Works were present as Staff liaisons.

APPROVAL OF MINUTES – December 3, 2019 – On motion of Dick Horton, seconded by John Robb, the minutes of December 3, 2019 were approved as submitted.

NOMINATION OF NEW CHAIRPERSON AND VICE CHAIRPERSON TO SERVE THE 2020 TERM – On motion of John Robb, seconded by Deborah McGeorge, Darrell Pulliam was nominated as Chairperson. On motion of John Robb, seconded by Deborah McGeorge, Deborah Anthony was nominated as Vice Chairperson. Both motions passed unanimously.

PROJECT UPDATES – Cameron Alden gave project updates for the KCS Crossing on Rouse, Memorial Drive Trail Project, and the North Medical District Trail.

MARKETING – Jacob Anselmi volunteered to assist with projects in the future.

QUADRANT SAFETY CONCERNS – There was a request to have turn lane signs further north on Centennial.

The Street Division is planning to place bollards near the pathway around Ron's to assist with stopping vehicle traffic from traveling this area.

There was a discussion regarding the promotion of the Adopt-A-Street Program.

There is a need for a representative from the Disability Community and the Northeast Quadrant.

ADJOURNMENT – There being no further business, the meeting adjourned at 12:40 p.m. The next tentatively scheduled meeting has been set for February 4, 2020.
