Kim Vogel indicated the preferred bike route signs will be installed once the weather clears up and isn't so wet.

MARKETING – Sarah Runyon indicated there is a Marketing Intern working on marketing information for the Active Transportation Advisory Board. She hopes to campaign the promotional information beginning in April and continuing through July. She presented ideas for activities such as Earth Day on April, 18, 2020, and partnerships in the community to promote Active Transportation Advisory Board. She also handed out a draft of the trails map. The group was encouraged to look it over and bring Sarah any updates they may find. This will be discussed again next month. Sarah put out information on the two open positions, the deadline for applications is February 14, 2020.

There wasn't anything new to report regarding quadrant safety concerns. Deborah McGeorge announced the new ADA ramps near her house on East 8th Street look really nice.

CRAWFORD COUNTY ATAB UPDATE – John Robb indicated a new name for the trail is being discussed at this time. The Crawford County ATAB Guidelines are being rewritten.
