

OFFICIAL MINUTES

July 7, 2020

A Regular Session of the Active Transportation Advisory Board was held at 12:01 p.m. on Tuesday, July 7, 2020, with a virtual via Go To Meeting, located inside City Hall, 201 West 4<sup>th</sup> Street, with Chairperson – Darrell Pulliam presiding and the following members present: Vice Chairperson – Debra Anthony, Deborah McGeorge, John Robb, Reno Cencora and Dick Horton was present as well as Kim Vogel, Director of Parks and Recreation and Cameron Alden, Director of Public Works were present as Staff liaisons and Erin Fletcher as a guest.

APPROVAL OF MINUTES – June 2, 2020 – On motion of Reno Cencora, seconded by Dick Horton, the minutes of June 2, 2020 were approved as submitted.

PROJECT UPDATES – Cameron Alden gave project updates Memorial Drive Trail Project, and the North Medical District Trail and the 4<sup>th</sup> Street Overpass being done by KDOT.

MARKETING – Darrell Pulliam indicated there were a few people that have taken photos of parks and trails and sent them to Sara Runyan. Sara will be posting the photos on the website and working on marketing materials for the ATAB.

SUSTAINABILITY – Dick Horton explained he would like to see this be a standing agenda item. He would like to see the tracking of the cost that is being spent on trails and alternative transportation. Dick Horton moved to have Sustainability Dash Board to be a standing item on the agenda. Reno Cencora seconded the motion. The motion passed unanimously.

SAFETY CONCERNS FROM QUADRANTS – the Pitt State Bike Trail near Names & Numbers has the bush that needs to be trimmed again. The pavement in the 1900 of J.F.K. is breaking up and it is difficult to ride a bike on. There is a need for sidewalks in the north end of town.

UPDATE OF TOP 5 PRIORITY LIST – After a brief discussion, this item will be set on the agenda next month after everyone sends their top 10 list to Cameron.

USD 250 – Cameron shared a few possibilities for possible alternative transportation and drop off zones to assist USD 250 with students who need to walk to school this Fall to relieve congestion at the school sites.

ADJOURNMENT – There being no further business, Darrell Pulliam moved, seconded by Dick Horton to adjourn the meeting at 12:30 p.m. The next tentatively scheduled meeting has been set for August 4, 2020.
