

OFFICIAL MINUTES
OF THE MEETING OF THE
ACTIVE TRANSPORTATION ADVISORY BOARD
CITY OF PITTSBURG, KANSAS
October 6, 2020

A Regular Session of the Active Transportation Advisory Board was held at 12:00 p.m. on Tuesday, October 6, 2020 located inside Shelter #3 at Lincoln Park, with Vice Chairperson – Debra Anthony, John Robb, Deborah McGeorge and Dick Horton were present as well as Kim Vogel, Director of Parks and Recreation and Cameron Alden were present as staff liaisons. Chairperson - Darrell Pulliam, Reno Cecora and Erin Fletcher were not in attendance.

APPROVAL OF MINUTES – September 1, 2020 – On motion of Horton, seconded by McGeorge, the minutes of September 1, 2020 were approved as submitted.

PROJECT UPDATES – Cameron Alden gave a brief update on the North Medical District sidewalk project; a design grant has been submitted to fund mobility from the hotels north of town.

MARKETING – Sara will be catching up with ATAB members to discuss content for information on trails.

SUSTAINABILITY – The election being held today will increase the amount set aside for sidewalks if passed.

SAFETY CONCERNS FROM QUADRANTS – There were no safety concerns at this time.

BIKE ROUTE 76 – John Robb explained the signs for this route are up, however they stop at City Limits and resume at the other end of town. It was requested to see if the City or KDOT will be responsible for the signs being installed on Broadway.

UPDATE OF TOP 5 PRIORITY LIST – Debra McGeorge will send out the list and have everyone prioritize that list. While they are prioritizing, they will think about feasibility, life safety and

Debra McGeorge indicated she was approached by Heather Horton to assist with completion of a grant for a bicycle rack near Toast. Cameron suggested the group write a letter of support. Anthony moved, seconded by McGeorge to request a letter of support from ATAB to go with the grant. McGeorge volunteered to draft the letter. Kim Vogel will be approaching Live Active or Live Well Crawford County to present the request to assist with the application.
