## Planning Commission/Board of Zoning Appeals Position Opening

The City of Pittsburg is seeking a volunteer to apply for appointment to the Planning Commission/Board of Zoning Appeals to fill an unexpired term to conclude on December 31, 2021. **Applications are due by 12:00 pm on Monday, August 16, 2021** and must be submitted to the City Clerk.

The Planning Commission/Board of Zoning Appeals reviews requests for variances in zoning ordinances, such as building setback requirements, building sizes, etc. Members of this commission review and adopt (as well as update) the Comprehensive Plan for the City of Pittsburg, establish zoning districts and allowable uses, review zoning regulations within the city and review requests for special permits or conditional uses within certain zoning districts in the city. Site plans for planned areas are also reviewed when this commission meets.

The candidate seeking to fill the vacancy will be serving as a resident of the City of Pittsburg. The appointment will be decided at the City Commission meeting on Tuesday, August 24<sup>th</sup>, 2021.
