Motion carried.

RESOLUTION NO. 1259 – On motion of Hite, seconded by McNay, the Governing Body approved Resolution No. 1259, amending Resolution No. 1248 establishing the equivalent residential unit, ERU rate and undeveloped property rate; and providing an effective date of January 1st, 2023, and authorized the Mayor to sign the Resolution on behalf of the City. THE FINISHING TOUCH – On motion of Hite, seconded by Munsell, the Governing Body approved the recommendation of the Economic Development Advisory Committee (EDAC) to allocate \$25,000 in non-repayable funds to be used specifically toward infrastructure improvements by The Finishing Touch at their facility located at 808 East Jefferson Street, based on an expected \$250,000 investment in the project by The Finishing Touch. Motion carried.



DVLP project

DVLP, a local development group, has proposed a significant redevelopment effort encompassing three downtown Pittsburg properties. Two of the spaces are located in the 100 block of North Broadway. At 113 N. Broadway, the Glick, named for a company that once occupied the building, will house 12 bedrooms in 10 apartments and 5,000 square feet of commercial space. Town Talk Studios, at 117 N. Broadway, is named for the bread logo on the side of the building, and will feature 19 bedrooms in 15 apartments and 7,500 square feet of commercial space.

The third property is located in the old Smith Clinic building at 902 N. Broadway. Dubbed the Smithsonian, it will have 21 bedrooms in 20 apartments.

DVLP representatives estimate the projected cost for the effort at \$4.8 million and recently applied for an economic development incentive package. The Economic Development Advisory Committee (EDAC) considered this request and voted to reimburse up to \$480,000 (or 10% of the total project value, whichever is less) to support the project. The funds will be distributed to the limited liability company (LLC) that owns each of the properties. These LLCs include: Smithsonian, LLC; Glick, LLC; and Town Talk, LLC. Up to one half of the City's funds would be dispersed in 2023, with the second half dispersed in 2024.

Please place this item on the agenda for the City Commission meeting scheduled for Tuesday, December 13, 2022. Action being requested is approval or denial of the EDAC recommendation to provide up to \$480,000 to assist with the DVLP redevelopment projects.




