ORDINANCE NO. G-1368

AN ORDINANCE creating Sections 70-1 and 70-2 in Chapter 70 of the Pittsburg City Code establishing solid waste collection rates and container fees for residential and commercial customers of the City's Property and Sanitation Department.

NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT ORDAINED BY THE GOVERNING BODY OF THE CITY OF PITTSBURG, KANSAS:

Section 1. Section 70-1 of the Pittsburg City Code is hereby created as follows:

The following monthly solid waste collection rates and container charges shall apply to residential and commercial customers of the City's Property and Sanitation Department:

1. Collection once per week:
 - a. One 96-gallon container.\$18.00
 - b. One 2 yard container\$60.00
 - c. One 4 yard container.\$80.00
2. Additional container fee:
 - a. 96 gallon container.\$9.00
 - b. 2 yard container.....\$30.00
 - c. 4 yard container.....\$40.00
3. Additional collections per week:
 - a. \$30.00 per additional collection.

Section 2. Section 70-2 of the Pittsburg City Code is created to read as follows:

The following solid waste collection rates and charges shall apply to residential and commercial customers of the City's Property Sanitation Department for bulky rubbish collection:

1. Bulky rubbish collection per occurrence:

- a. Refuse items that individually weigh less than fifty pounds and have height, width and length dimensions less than four feet on any side\$10.00
- b. Refuse items that individually weigh more than fifty pounds or have height, width or length dimensions exceeding four feet on any side\$20.00
- c. Refuse items that either cannot be transported by Property and Sanitation Department equipment, or due to the nature or composition of the item requires specialized handling\$30.00

Section 3. This ordinance shall take effect and be in force January 1, 2025 after its passage and publication of its summary in the official city paper.
