3. Special Guest - Sgt. Travis Bowman, Pittsburg Police Department

- Officer Bowman wanted to know what the NAC sees as a need
 - Homeless population concerns
 - PD and Municipal Court partnering with CHC and CCMH
 - Municipal Court working with a diversion program
 - Numerous citations based on new ordinances
 - Neighborhood Watch Topic
 - PD oversaw the NWP in the past, but it is not currently operated
 - Ryan mentioned that one of our goals is to assist in the possibility of helping neighborhoods form a Neighborhood Watch
 - Officer Bowman will check on what is required to implement a Neighborhood Watch
 - Property Maintenance is key Phase 1
 - Landscaping
 - Lighting
 - Deter criminals
 - Cameras Phase 2

- Make sure they are visible
- Locks Phase 3
 - Make sure visually obvious
- Ryan Williams asked about communication on progress
 - o How do we improve communication with the public on what is being done?
 - PJ thought communication on graphics, fliers, social media content that we as NAC members could share
 - Lacy commented that progress is hard to share
 - Kristin suggested we add this content to the welcome package
 - Property maintenance, days for recycle collection, Burn site info etc.
 - PJ suggested information on Renters Rights
- Kristin asked Officer Bowman on what we can do to help PD
 - o Officer Bowman mentioned the importance of getting the word out and get to know each other
 - The NAC is proof that we still care about our neighbors
 - Connecting neighbors and establishing groups will naturally improve safety
 - See Click Fix is helpful
 - Officer Bowman mentioned that he is available to be contacted by NAC members for questions and support
- Matt Bacon
 - Update on NAC-ATAB combination
 - Active Transportation goal was connectivity of the town
 - With the NAC, ATAB planned to look more to the NAC to work towards those goals
 - Might dissolve the ATAB and transition to NAC
 - ATAB formed in 2014 and they make recommendations on Safe Routes to Schools and sidewalk inventory
 - o Request would be to dissolve the ATAB and transition to NAC
 - Follow-up with ordinance actions needed
 - ATAB was primarily helpful in recommendations for grant applications
- Ryan Williams
 - Countryside Park Project
 - Approval to buy 3 acres behind the park
 - Grants for equipment and improvements
 - Inviting neighborhood to gather and start the process of the Neighborhood Association
 - Aiming for Fall to complete the project
 - Park equipment is expensive
 - 2/1/25 Neighborhood Event 9-11am coffee and donuts
 - NAC members welcome to come join
