APPROVAL OF MINUTES – The November 4th, 2024, Airport Advisory Board meeting minutes were approved as presented.

AIRPORT RECONSTRUCTION OF THE PARTIAL PARALLEL TAXIWAY TO RUNWAY 04/22 PROJECT – Construction plans issued to the FAA for 90% review. Project will then go out for bid, with a possible start in the fall of 2025. All depending on available FAA and City funding.

FAA FIVE-YEAR CAPITAL IMPROVEMENT PLAN (CIP) – Data sheets with potential projects for the next five years were presented by Brian Coomes.

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STATE OF KANSAS AIRPORT IMPROVEMENT PROGRAM (KAIP) – Bill Pyle and Brian Coomes gave information on submitted grant applications for updating the airport layout plan and t-hangar taxilane improvements.
