CALL TO ORDER – The meeting was called to order at 12:00 p.m.

APPROVAL OF MINUTES – The May 5th, 2025, Airport Advisory Board meeting minutes were approved as presented.

RECONSTRUCTION OF THE PARTIAL PARALLEL TAXIWAY TO RUNWAY 04/22 PROJECT – Bill gave an update on the project. Contractor Emery Sapp will submit concrete mix design to FAA for approval and then in the Spring of 2026, the start date will be set.

STATE OF KANSAS AIRPORT IMPROVEMENT PROGRAM (KAIP) – Bill gave an update on the State of Kansas grant to revise the Airport Layout Plan. Olsson will develop a focused (ALP) concentrating on the Eastern terminal pavement rehabilitation and integration of a self-service fuel system.

NON-AGENDA REPORTS AND REQUESTS:

Ron Brock gave a brief discussion on planning and design for a future airport terminal building. He asked members for their thoughts on what the terminal could resemble.

Geoffrey asked about T-Hangars possibly needing roof vents. Bill talked about having a Structural Engineer evaluate the hangars and determine what issues need repaired and the cost to do so.

Bill gave an update on the Tommy Atkinson Monument. WSU Technical School Masonry Class will start rehab on the monument on August 18th. They will be tuck pointing joints around stones and replacing concrete sidewalk. The American Legion and AVAIL Enclosure Systems will be providing funds/materials for the project.

Bill talked about having a community open house event at the airport in the Spring of 2026. We will team up with KDOT Aviation to create a local event that highlights the role that the airport plays. There will be aviation related businesses and local based aircraft participating. We will invite the community and local schools to the event.
