Special Guest:

- **Lt. Adan Nance, Pittsburg Police Department – Pittsburg Lighting Survey** - *Nance will share an update on the PD's city-wide lighting survey and answer questions.*
 - PD identified areas that need brighter lights and areas with no lighting, used drone technology – 459 total recommendations (approx. 300 with no lighting, also included tree trimming spots). This report was overlayed with “heat” (crime spots) areas. The first phase will be to address areas needing brighter lights, then phase two, areas with no lighting. Shared overlay maps.

 - Tree inquired about how PD is addressing parking
 - Lt. Nance stated that they are identifying issues with larger trucks/vehicles and parking duration
