CALL TO ORDER – The meeting was called to order at 12:00 p.m.

APPROVAL OF MINUTES – The August 4th, 2025, Airport Advisory Board meeting minutes were approved as presented.

RECONSTRUCTION OF THE PARTIAL PARALLEL TAXIWAY TO RUNWAY 04/22 PROJECT – Bill and Brian gave an update on the project. The project is on schedule to start in the Spring of 2026. The construction date will be set after the spring raining season ends.

RUNWAY 17/35 REHAB PROJECT – Bill and Brian gave an update on the project. The project will be for crack sealing, sealcoating, and painting the full length and width of the runway. The runway will be closed during the project. The project will be funded by a 95%/5% FAA grant. The project date will possibly be Spring of 2027.
