**ORDINANCE NO. G-1388**

AN ORDINANCE amending Section 6-5 of the Pittsburg City Code to allow the sale at retail of cereal malt beverage and alcoholic liquor in the original package within the City between the hours of 6:00 a.m. to 5:00 a.m. beginning on June 11, 2026 and ending on July 19, 2026.

NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT ORDAINED BY THE GOVERNING BODY OF THE CITY OF PITTSBURG, KANSAS:

Section 1. Section 6-5 of the Pittsburg City Code is amended to read as follows:

**Sec. 6-5. Sale at retail.**

The sale at retail of cereal malt beverage in the original package is allowed within the City on any Sunday, except Easter, between the hours of noon and 8:00 p.m.


The sale at retail of alcoholic liquor in the original package is allowed within the City on any Sunday, except Easter, between the hours of noon and 8:00 p.m.

The sale at retail of alcoholic liquor in the original package is allowed within the City on Memorial Day, Independence Day, and Labor Day.

The sale at retail of cereal malt beverage and alcoholic liquor in the original package is allowed within the City between the hours of 6:00 a.m. to 5:00 a.m., beginning on June 11, 2026 and ending on July 19, 2026.

Section 2. This Ordinance shall take effect upon its passage and publication of its summary in the official city newspaper.
